## **Multiplier event in Florence**


In order to reach a greater number of users, two multiplier events were organized in Florence (24 May 2024) and in the municipality of San Casciano Val di Pesa (4 July 2024) in which a total of 42 people participated (24 in Florence and 18 in San Casciano Val di Pesa). During the multiplier events, the L2 teaching methodologies developed during the project and contained in the DIDLAGO manual were illustrated.











### **Multiplier event in Florence**

The DIDLAGO manual was distributed in electronic form (via email) to the various participants so that they can use it during their future teaching activities (and learning) of the Italian language aimed at adult citizens with a migratory background. The meetings were an opportunity to establish closer relationships with various reception centers for migrants and informal schools where Italian L2 teaching activities are carried out in order to verify, in the future, the validity of the distributed materials, their improvement according to the real student needs and possible future project developments. The courses were organized in collaboration with the teachers of the Linguaggi in Movimento cooperative and with the participation of eight students from the Italian L2 courses.



























## **Multiplier event in Palermo**

On the 21st June, within the official celebration of the International Refugee Week, promoted by the Municipality of Palermo, Per Esempio has organised the presentation of the final results of the project, focusing on the concrete experiences of the local community.

More than 40 people have participated: representatives of the civil society at local and international level, EU citizens, people with a migration background, representatives of the public authorities and many youngsters from reception centers for refugees.








## **Multiplier event in Cham**






# **DIDAGLO** Manual in all partners' languages














### **ALL IN FACEBOOK PAGE**
